BRITISH RIDDEN HORSE ANNUAL PERFORMANCE AWARD

The BRHHS offer an Enthusiasts / Performance Award based on an annual points awards scheme aimed at those owners who regularly champion the above ridden heavy horse breeds at events , shows, competitions around the country.

Special rosette will be awarded
to the annual highest points winners in each breed section.

RULES / INFORMATION

The Performance Award is a competitive scheme for ridden heavy horses registered in the following British Stud Books - Clydesdale, British Percheron, Shire, Suffolk Horse Societies.

The competition is an annual one that runs for one year from 1 January 2014 to 31st December 2014

Horses must be 4 years old and over and be registered with their respective Breed Society.

The card must be completed in the registered name of the horse with Society Stud Book Number.

Each horse / rider combination must have a separate card.

The scheme is open to stallions, mares and geldings.

Points will be awarded as follows 7 for 1st place, 6 for 2nd place, 5 for third place, 4 for fourth place, 3 for fifth place 2 for sixth place and 1 Point will be awarded for all unplaced participants who enter a competition. At riding club level only one event from the day to apply.

Non showing / competitive events e.g. Demonstrations / heavy horse days etc under saddle 5 points per event.

Cards must be signed by the judge or official at the show / event where the horse has competed. This also applies for participation points.

Cards must be returned to the British Ridden Heavy Horse Society by 31st December 2014.
